SUBJECT: ARTISANAL GOLD MINING IN KENYA

Kenya is signatory to the Minamata Convention on Mercury. Kenya has also done a preliminary inventory of Mercury supply, use and emissions. It has determined that ASGM in Kenya's territory is "more than insignificant".
